To further develop my understanding of business principles, I joined Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA). Collaborating with fellow students, I developed a franchise business plan for Cafe Du Monde in New Orleans, strengthening my financial and logistical knowledge. Courses such as Mathematics and English have aided my development into a broadly educated and well-rounded individual, providing me with problem-solving, analytical thinking, and persuasive communication skills. Attending lectures by world-class professors at the University of Pennsylvania Wharton Leadership Business Academy, I gained a foundational understanding of effective leadership strategies, risk management and competitive advantage. The Saturn Parable Simulation, a team race to determine who can land on one of Saturn's moons first, was particularly illuminating as it highlighted the importance of teamwork and cooperation in a business setting. Running this stand taught me to think in a more detail-oriented and organised manner whilst maintaining a calm and efficient work environment; qualities that will aid the success of my undergraduate studies. Throughout my high school career, I have focused on developing the depth of my theoretical

understanding and practical experience of business theory, and these skills have instilled in me tenacity, organisation and the ability to apply effective strategies across a range of business scenarios.
